

INTESA SANPAOLO RECEIVED TWO IMPORTANT RECOGNITIONS FOR ITS COMMITMENT TOWARDS THE ENVIRONMENT

On April 14 in Rome, on the occasion of ECOPOLIS, the International Conference for urban environment and sustainable cities promoted by The Rome Chamber of Commerce and Fiera Roma, Intesa Sanpaolo received a special mention in the section "Management" within the Business Award for the Environment. 130 projects have been submitted.

The aim of the award is to give recognition to private and public businesses which commit themselves in initiatives for a sustainable development, environmental protection and corporate responsibility.

This is the Italian selection of the European Business Award for the Environment promoted in 1987 by the European Commission – D.G. Environment.

Intesa Sanpaolo has been awarded thanks to its environmental management, that is part of a wider commitment aimed at including the CSR values in its daily business.

On April 15, in Rome a special mention was assigned to the bank within the Sustainable Projects Green Public Procurement 2010 Award, section "Large Enterprises". The award, promoted by the Ministry of Economy and Finance and by Consip Spa, intends to give recognition to the best practices in carrying out policies respectful to environmental impacts.
